### Youth With A Mission - Ocean City, NJ

- 1987 During extended time of prayer & fasting, received call to mobilize students into nations through vocations.
- 1996 Established 501(c)(3) in Virginia. Formed international YWAM Staff team.
- 2004 Pioneered a 12-week YWAM Staff training school in INDIA.
- 2013 Created & tested Converge prototype.
- 2016 Established YWAM location in Ocean City, NJ. Led first Discipleship Training School.

### The Ministry Model

After 25 years directing YWAM sponsored internship program, we have developed Converge, a searchable registry of internship opportunities, a missional learning course, and a social fundraising platform to equip emerging leaders.

### Ministry Success Indicators and Expansion Goals

- In the past 3 years, we have established a ministry presence in Ocean City, NJ, completed MVP software for Converge platform, and trained 8 students in our first 6-month intensive Discipleship Training School.
- Recruit 75 hosts for 150 internship opportunities for 300 participants by the end of 2017.
- Build an organization with active local board and add seven new staff by Dec. 2017.

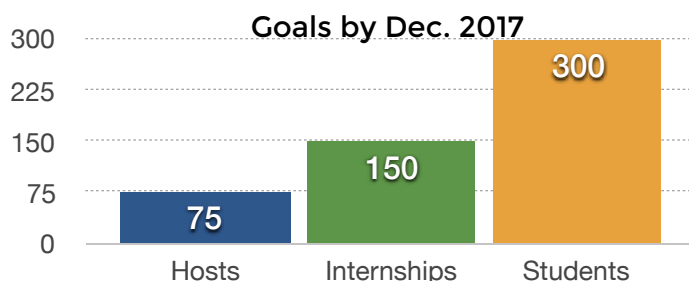

### Results to Date

- Past interns installed water pumps, worked in orphanages, hospices, schools and clinics. They also helped plant churches and businesses.
- To date, we have coordinated 75 internships (300+ students from over 100 universities to over 35 countries). Dozens of these young men and women are now leading in their fields with missional focus.



### Immediate Ministry Needs

- \$5,000 to hire software engineer to complete Converge platform and testing by Dec 2016.
- \$7,700 to provide scholarships for students from majority world by Mar 2017.
- \$1,500/month housing for volunteer staff and interns by Jan 2017.
